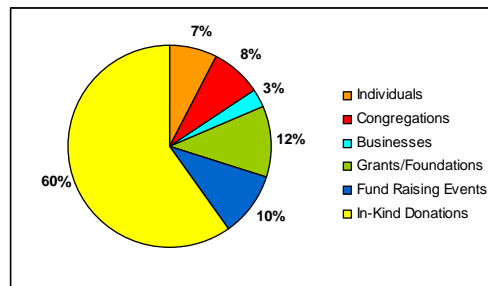

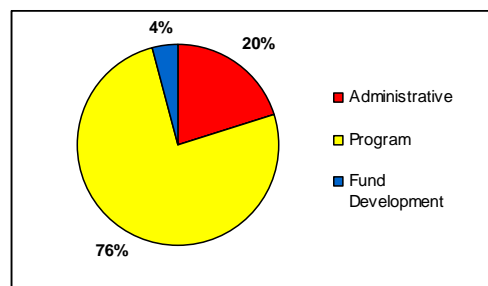
TOTAL INCOME = \$682,007.73

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 20 families, comprised of 26 adults and 38 children, were served. 75% of families were single parent households.
- 53% of children served were age 5 and younger.
- The average stay was 62 days.
- 3,722 bed nights of lodging and 11,166 meals were provided.
- 12 child care scholarships were provided.
- Financial counseling and case management services were provided to all families.
- \$31,880 in donated items was collected, including furniture and 2 used automobiles.
- 1,650 volunteers provided over 19,388 hours of service.
- 92% of guest families left the program with employment & housing.
